Product Description

Biuret is an ADM exclusive non-protein (NPN) source. Biuret is a controlled-release NPN source that produces an ammonia release pattern in the rumen that is similar to soybean meal. In contrast to the rapid release of urea, biuret's predictable ammonia release allows for greater formulation flexibility for cattle (beef and dairy), sheep, and goats. Biuret is ideal for range supplements or other free-choice feeding methods where controlled ammonia release provides greater performance and limits ammonia toxicity risks.

Usage

Use only in mixed feeds for ruminants.

When equivalent crude protein from all forms of non-protein nitrogen (including biuret) exceeds one-third of the total crude protein in the total daily ration, care should be taken to assure that the diet is balanced to provide adequate nutrients.

WARNING: This feed should be used only in accordance with directions furnished on the label.

Physical Characteristics & Handling

Biuret is a free-flowing, fine, white granular meal. Its chemical properties make it less hygroscopic (attracts less water) compared to urea. This aspect makes biuret easier to handle and mix and to be less likely to cake and bridge compared to urea.
