



## Sheep Quick Reference Guide



### Complete Lamb Feeds

ADM's Complete Lamb Feeds are pelleted, grain mixes that supply energy, protein, minerals, and vitamins to help ensure fast, efficient gains for lambs from birth to finish.

- Varying protein options — Match protein needs to growth stage
- Complete feeds — No need to purchase, inventory, or add other supplements to the diet
- Highly digestible fiber sources — Supply energy and help ensure healthy rumen function
- CitriStim<sup>®</sup>, an ADM proprietary feed ingredient that may favorably impact the gut microbial population (not included in 15% Lamb Grower)
- No added copper — Helps lessen the risk of copper toxicity
- Chelated (organic) zinc — Shown to support hoof health and immune function
- Thiamine — Helps deter polioencephalomalacia
- Niacin — For its influence on efficiency and gains in growing/finishing lambs consuming high-energy, protein diets
- Molybdenum — To help tie-up excess copper naturally-occurring in feedstuffs
- Ammonium chloride — Has been shown to help lessen the likelihood of urinary calculi in male sheep
- 2:1 calcium to phosphorus ratio — Helps deter urinary calculi in male sheep
- Salt — Encourages water consumption which may help deter urinary calculi
- Medicated with lasalocid for prevention of coccidiosis (non-medicated options are available)

- 21% protein, 3.5% fat, and 12% fiber max.
- Utilizes patented cold pelleting technology
  - Feed stays fresh longer compared to texturized feed
  - Enables usage of similar amount of molasses without stickiness, caking and bricking associated with conventional pelleted and texturized feeds containing molasses
  - Doesn't dry out like texturized feed
- PremiDex<sup>™</sup> supports beneficial change in gut microflora
